A LETTER FROM THE ALUMNI DIRECTOR

Dear Brothers,

This semester has been a busy one for the Alpha Nu Chapter. Both undergraduates and alumni have been hard at working helping to continue the long history and traditions of our Chapter. Here are some highlights from this fall:

Renovations: Renovations on the house are in full swing thanks to the generous donations of some of our alumni. Renovations started this fall on the first floor of the house where the dining room received a new floor and ceiling as well as new recessed lighting fixtures.
